IMF Articles of Agreement

Article 12, Section 3 (b)

The Executive Board shall consist of Executive Directors with the Managing Director as chairman. Of the Executive Directors:

- (i) five shall be appointed by the five members having the largest quotas; and
- (ii) fifteen shall be elected by the other members. [...]

ILO Constitution

Article 7

1. The Governing Body shall consist of fifty-six persons:

- Twenty-eight representing governments,
- Fourteen representing the employers, and
- Fourteen representing the workers.

2. Of the twenty-eight persons representing governments, ten shall be appointed by the Members of chief industrial importance, and eighteen shall be appointed by the Members selected for that purpose by the Government delegates to the Conference, excluding the delegates of the ten Members mentioned above.

ICAO Convention on International Civil Aviation

Article 50 (b)

In electing the members of the Council, the Assembly shall give adequate representation to 1) the States of chief importance in air transport; 2) the States not otherwise included which make the largest contribution to the provision of facilities for international civil air navigation; and 3) the States not otherwise included whose designation will insure that all the major geographic areas of the world are represented on the Council. [...]

IMO Convention on the International Maritime Organization

Article 17

In electing the Members of the Council, the Assembly shall observe the following criteria:

- (a) Eight shall be States with the largest interest in providing international shipping services;
- (b) Eight shall be other States with the largest interest in international seaborne trade;

- (c) Sixteen shall be States not elected under (a) or (b) above which have special interests in maritime transport or navigation, and whose election to the Council will ensure the representation of all major geographic areas of the world.

FAO Constitution

Article XVI: Legal Status

1. The Organization shall have the capacity of a legal person to perform any legal act appropriate to its purpose which is not beyond the powers granted to it by this Constitution.

IAEA Statute

Article 6

A. The Board of Governors shall be composed as follows:

1. The outgoing Board of Governors shall designate for membership on the Board the ten members most advanced in the technology of atomic energy including the production of source materials, and the member most advanced in the technology of atomic energy including the production of source materials in each of the following areas in which none of the aforesaid ten is located:

1. North America
2. Latin America
3. Western Europe
4. Eastern Europe
5. Africa
6. Middle East and South Asia
7. South East Asia and the Pacific
8. Far East.

UNIDO Constitution

Article 9 Industrial Development Board

1. The Board shall consist of 53 Members of the Organization elected by the Conference, which shall give due regard to the principle of equitable geographical distribution. In electing the members of the Board the Conference shall observe the following distribution of seats: 33 members of the Board shall be elected from the States listed in Parts A and C. 15 from the States listed in Part B, and 5 from the States listed in Part D of Annex I to this Constitution.
